The purpose of this exercise is to introduce pipeline operators to emergency responders prior to a pipeline incident. We want to work together to be prepared for the unlikely event of a natural gas pipeline rupture or leak.

We hope to provide you with information about transporting a variety of products through pipelines, how to recognize a potential leak, and how to appropriately respond if an incident should occur. Following the session, we will have an open discussion to review the outcome of the tabletop exercise and to answer any questions the responders might have for the pipeline operators – or vice versa!
