

## Pipeline Emergency Response Training

The Pipeline Association of the Northwest (PANW) is comprised of 15 pipeline operators with facilities in Idaho, Oregon, and Washington. They are offering **FREE** pipeline emergency response training covering the basic properties of natural gas and other petroleum products as well as hazmat response, meters, and command center coordination.

Experienced hazmat instructors are available for day, evening, and weekend training sessions. The sessions typically are 2-3 hours long and involve interactive exercises customized to meet the needs of your organization. Local pipeline operator personnel will be there to provide specific information about their facilities and response capabilities.
